

Treaty City Invitational Hosted by the Greenville Cross Country Program

Date: Saturday, September 4, 2021

Location: Memorial Hill in the Greenville City Park, 202 Memorial Drive

Course will be open for inspection at 7am. Course includes mostly grass but does include a crossing over a true swinging bridge and a few road crossings.

Race Schedule:

8:30am – Middle School Girls

9am – Middle School Boys

9:30am – “Green Race” Girls (unlimited)

10:10 – “Green Race” Guys (unlimited)

10:50 – “White Race” Girls (unlimited)

11:30 – “White Race” Guys (unlimited)

Depending upon number of entries, a JV race may need to be added as we are currently expecting 23 schools. If this happens, we will add the JV race between the two divisional groups.

Schools by Division: White Race=Small (D3) schools/Green Race=Larger (D2 and D1) schools. Due to traffic at the bridge/safety reasons, we ask that you limit your Middle School entries to athletes who can complete the distance within 30 mins, and limit High School entries to those who can complete the race distance within 40 mins.
